Overview

This year marks the 25th anniversary of the 16 Days of Activism Against Gender-Based Violence Campaign, initiated in 1991 and coordinated by the Center for Women's Global Leadership. In this context, the Ministry of Gender Equality, Child Development and Family Welfare, in collaboration with the Mauritius Film Development Corporation and Passerelle, a registered NGO in Mauritius that caters for women and children in distress, is organising a short film competition to raise awareness on Gender-Based Violence.

Theme

"Aret violans domestik"

Goals

- (a) Raise general awareness about domestic violence during the 16 days activism;
- (b) Encourage participation in the 16 Days Activism Against Gender-Based Violence campaign;
and
- (c) Enhance and promote young and independent local movie productions.

Specifications

- (a) This competition is exclusively dedicated to short video clips of 3 minutes (opening and closing credits included).
- (b) Language used should be English, French or Creole.

Format

Broadcast quality examples: - HD, MP4 amongst others.

Category

Fiction

Conditions

- (a) The competition is free and open to every citizen of Mauritius regardless of their age.
- (b) Each participant may submit more than one clip. In this case he/she must fill out a separate registration for each work submitted.
- (c) Participating in this competition automatically entails acceptance of these conditions.
- (d) Submission should:
 - i. not be of pornographic nature;
 - ii. be apolitical; and
 - iii. should not contain materials/stories/pictures which could cause prejudice to any component of the Mauritian community.
- (e) All clips should be submitted within the deadline.

- (c) Each envelope must contain:
 - The application form duly signed in original;
 - One copy of the clip on a DVD or pen drive; and
 - Information sheet including synopsis, movie details such as title, duration, participant, cast and credit).

Selection

The participants will be informed of the outcome of the clips submitted for the competition.

A panel of Jury will be appointed for the selection of the best clips. The decision of the Jury panel will be final. All selected clips will be given an assistance of Rs 10,000.

Prizes

1st Prize: Cash prize of Rs 30,000

2nd Prize: Cash prize of Rs 20,000

3rd Prize: Cash prize of Rs 10,000

All participants will receive a certificate of participation.
